ALPHABET CUE CARD – LABELLED LINES

Top Line: Tall letters start at the top line



Dotted Interline: Small letters start at or just below the dotted interline

Baseline: All letters sit on the baseline

Digger letters dig below the baseline to the next interline or line

Key Strategies for Neat Printing - Downers



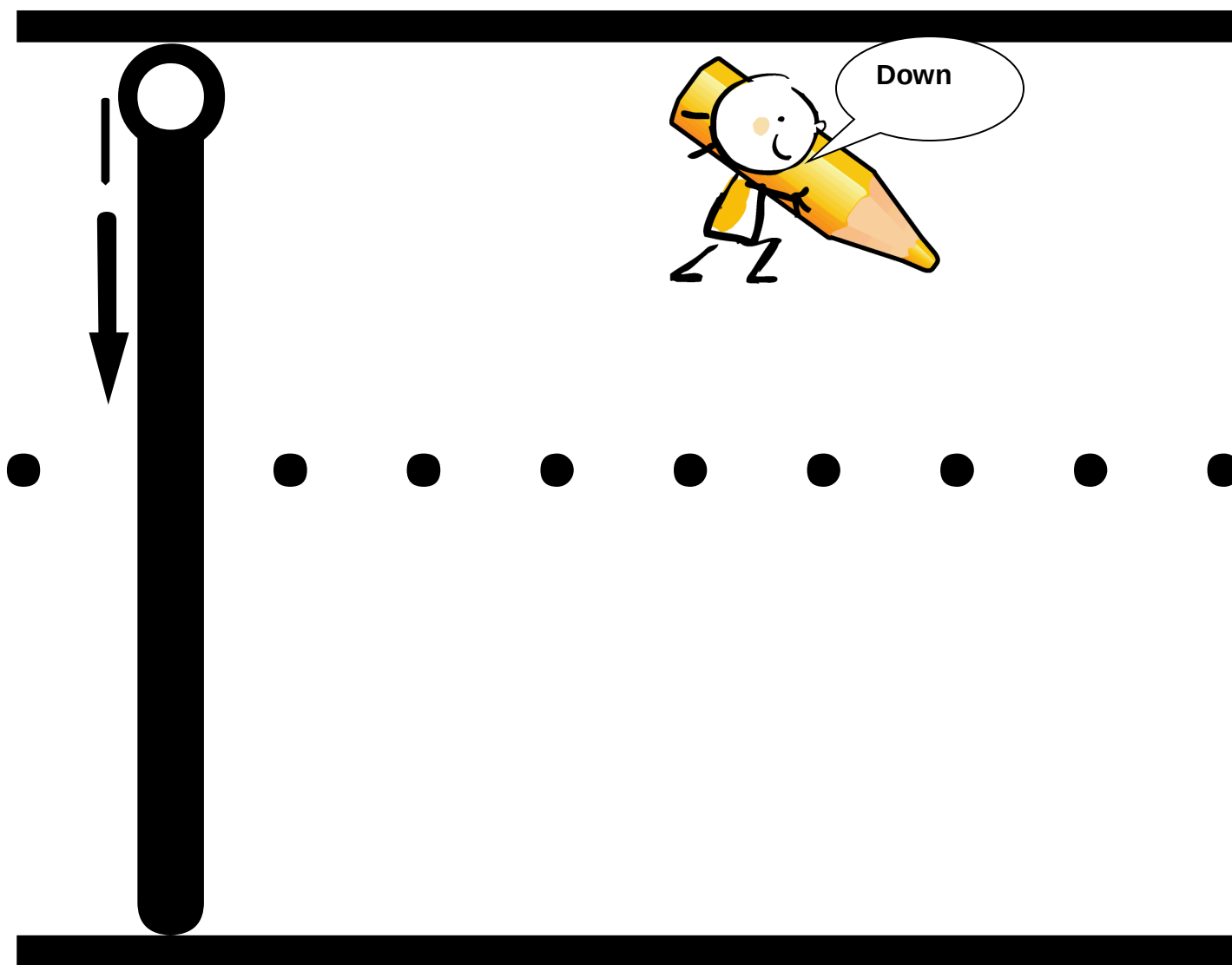
My strategies for neat printing of Downers:

- ☐ **Print small letters small (i)**

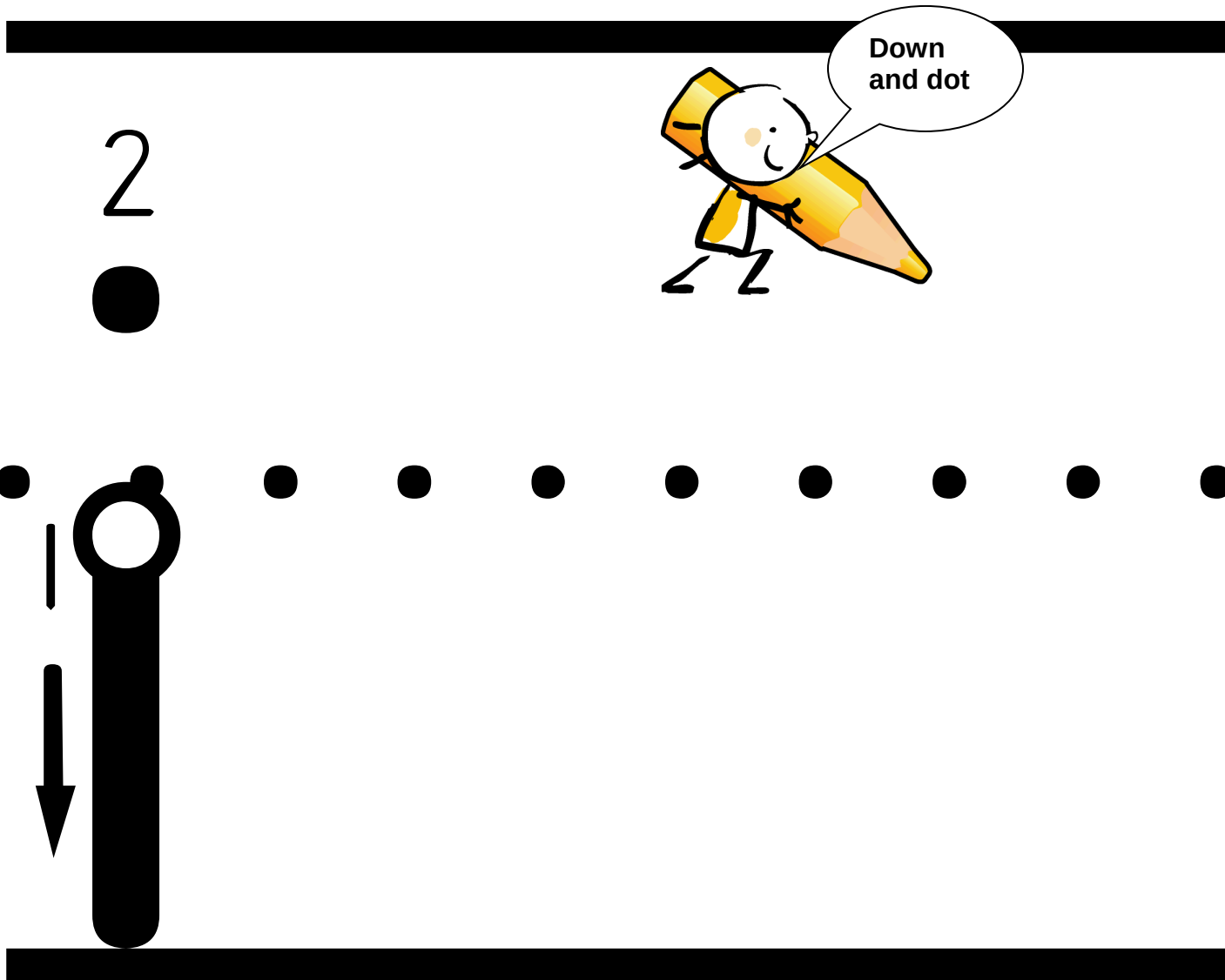

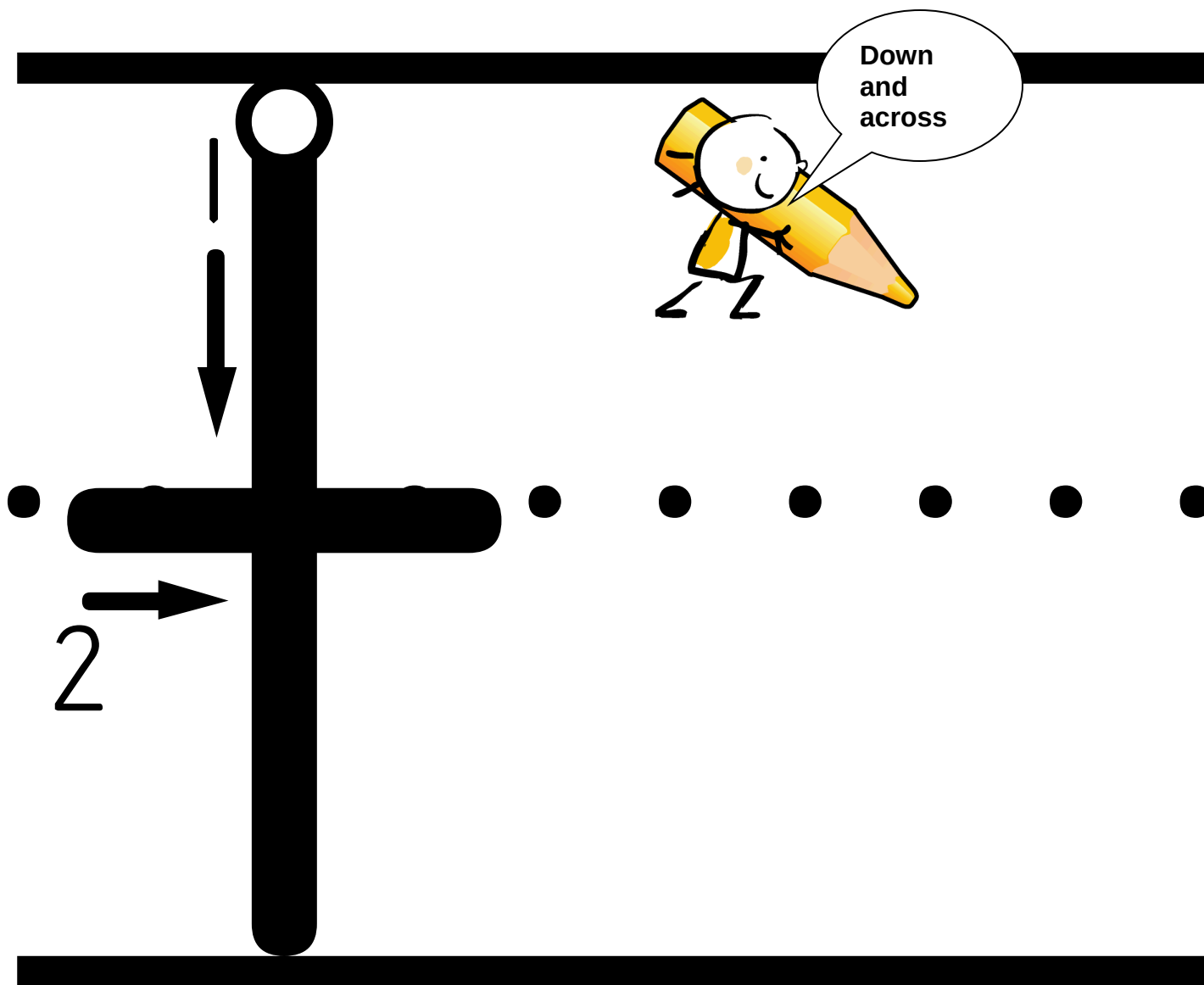

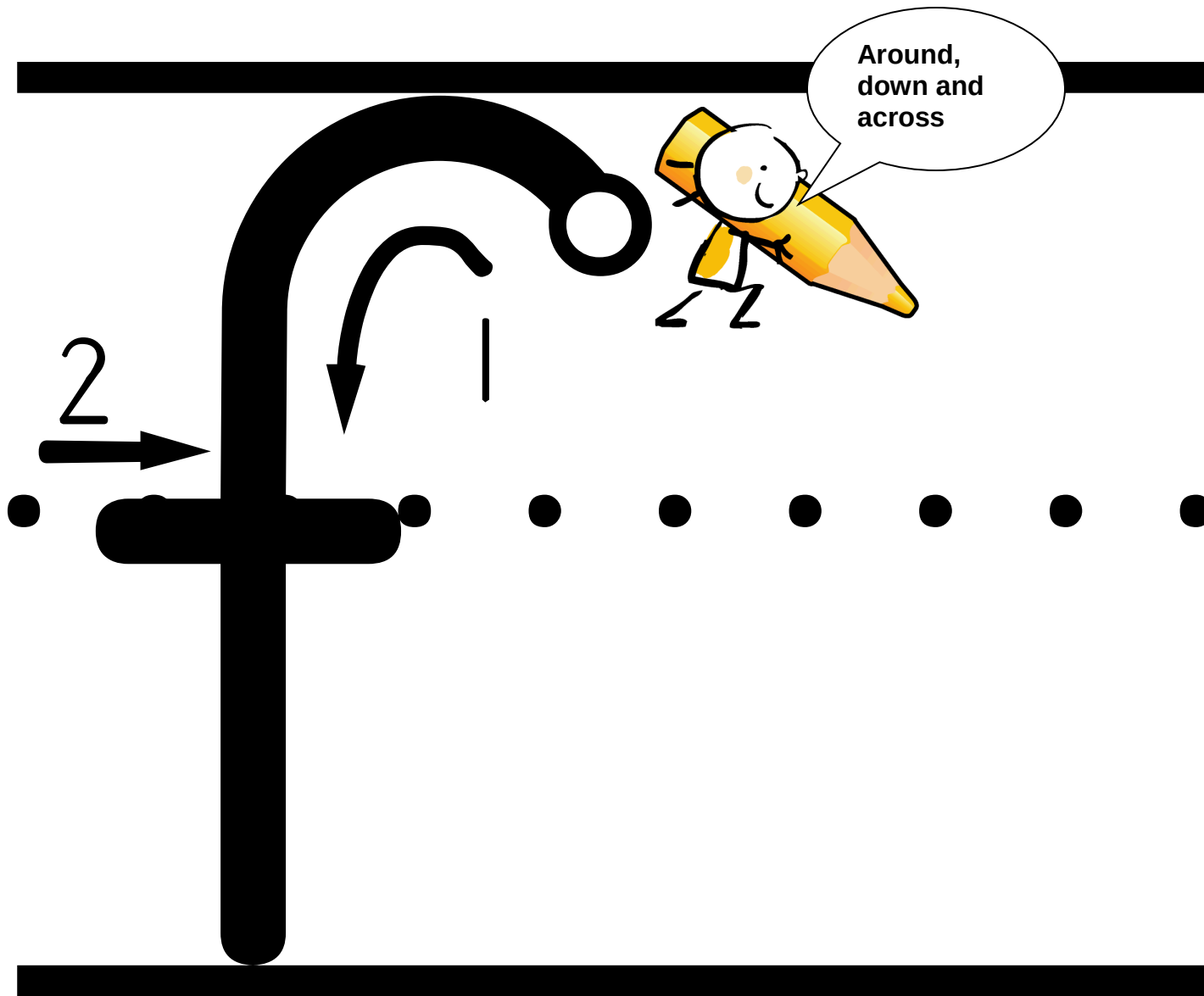

Key Strategies for Neat Printing - Rounders



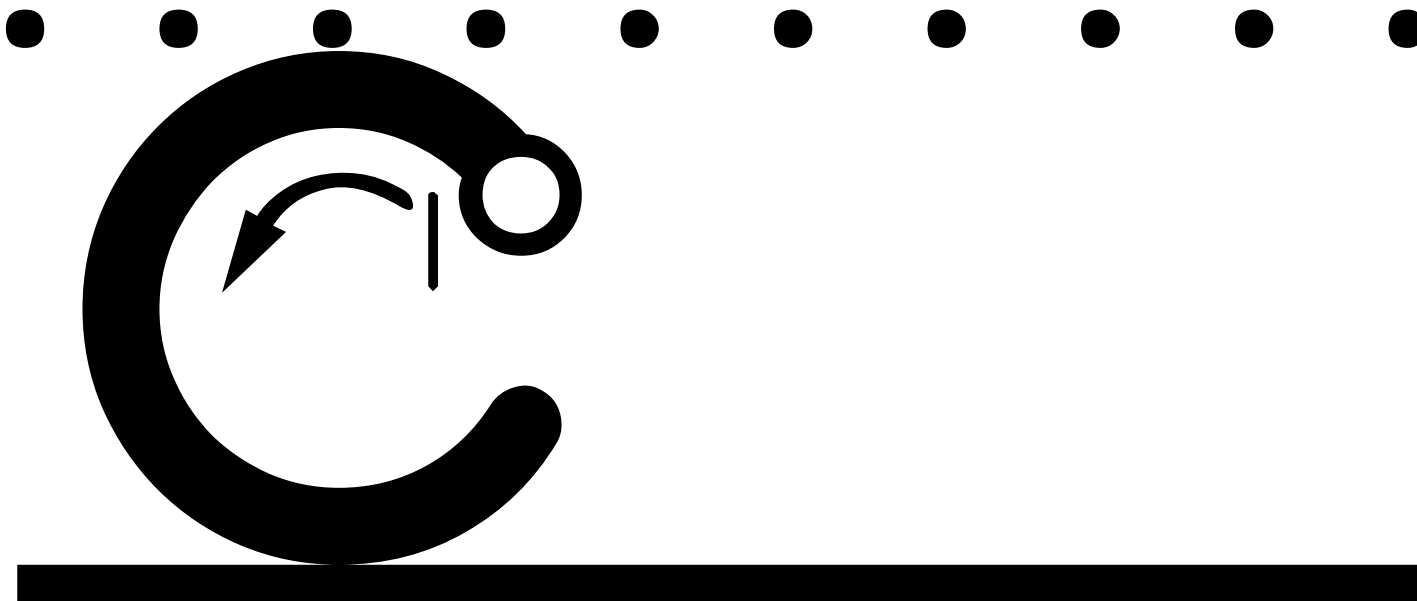
My strategies for neat printing of Rounders:

- ☐ **Print small letters small (c, o, a, e)**

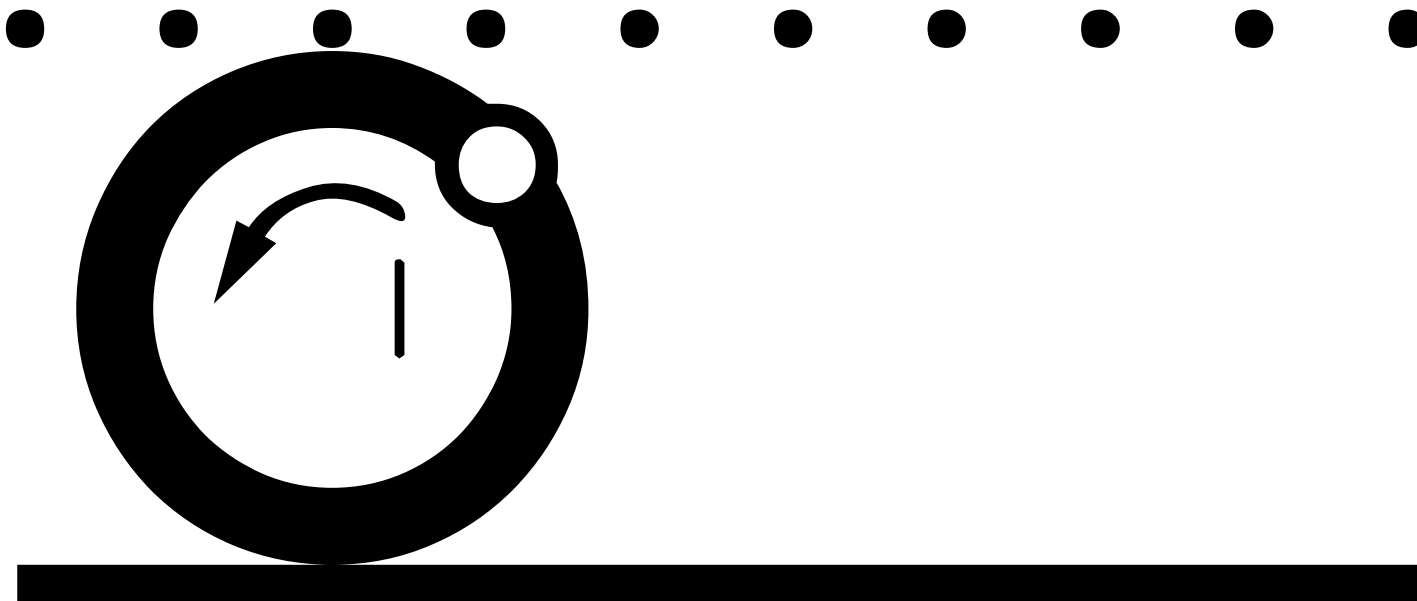
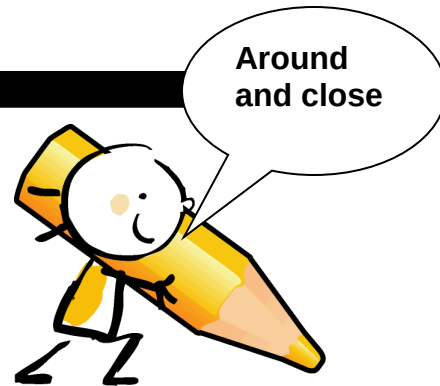

Key Strategies for Neat Printing - Curvers



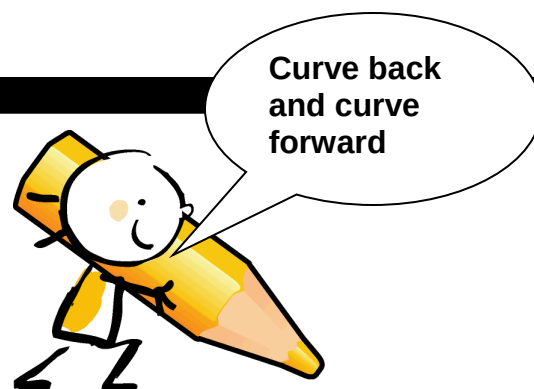
My strategies for neat printing of Curvers:

- ☐ **Print small letters small (s, u, r, n, m)**

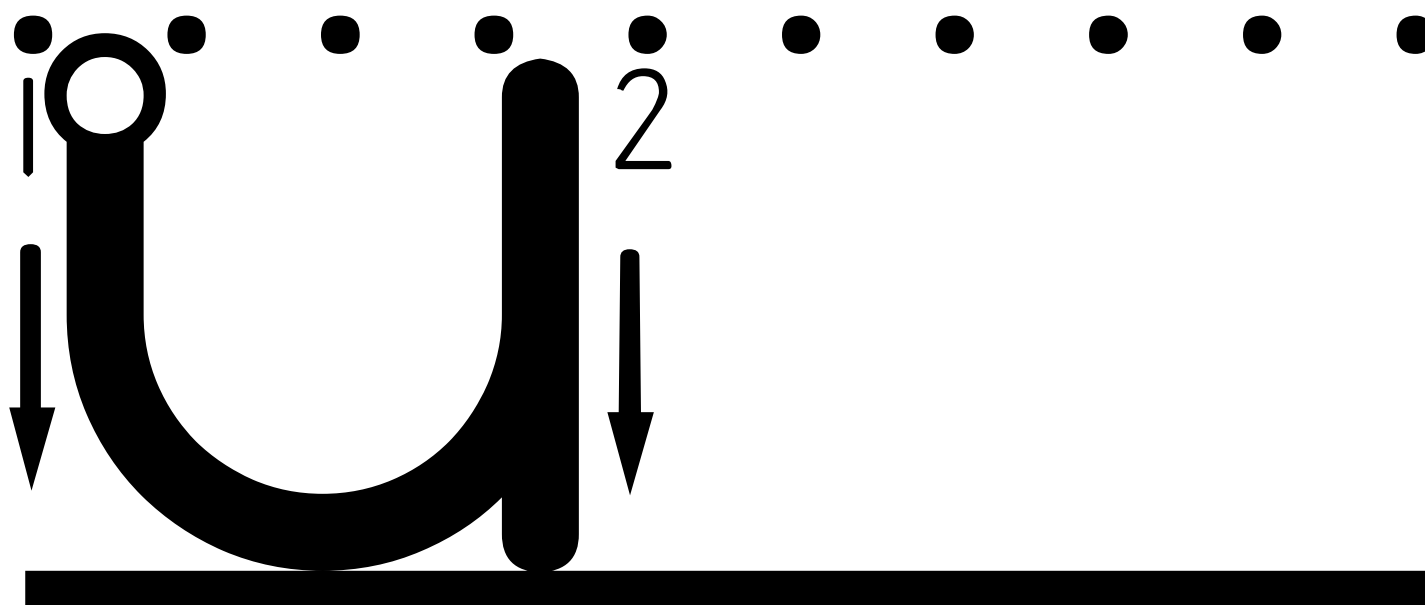
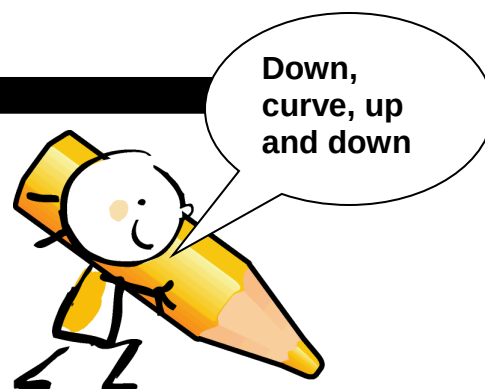

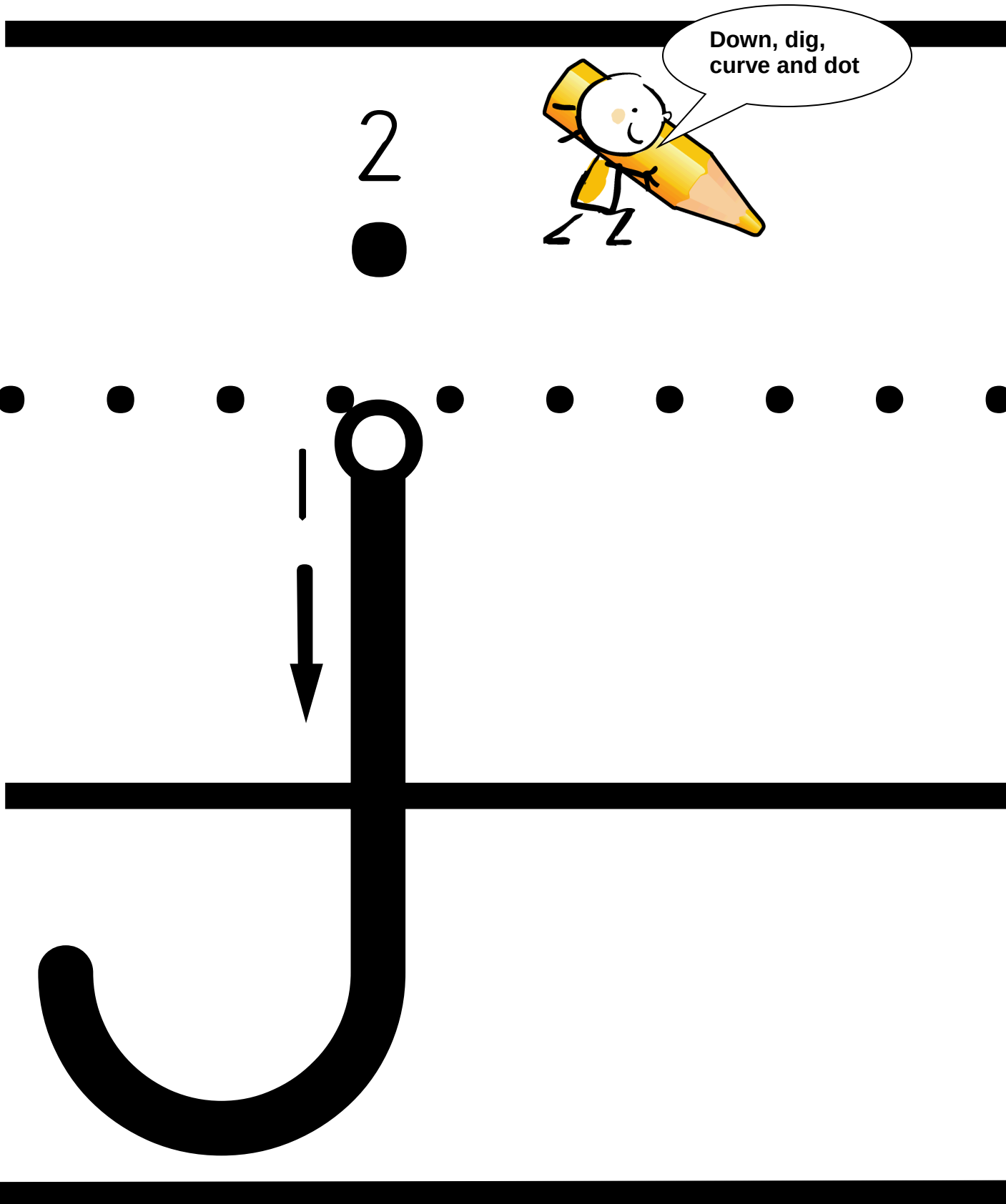
My strategies for neat printing of Diggers:

- ☐ Print “digger” letters digging down below baseline (j, g, q, p)

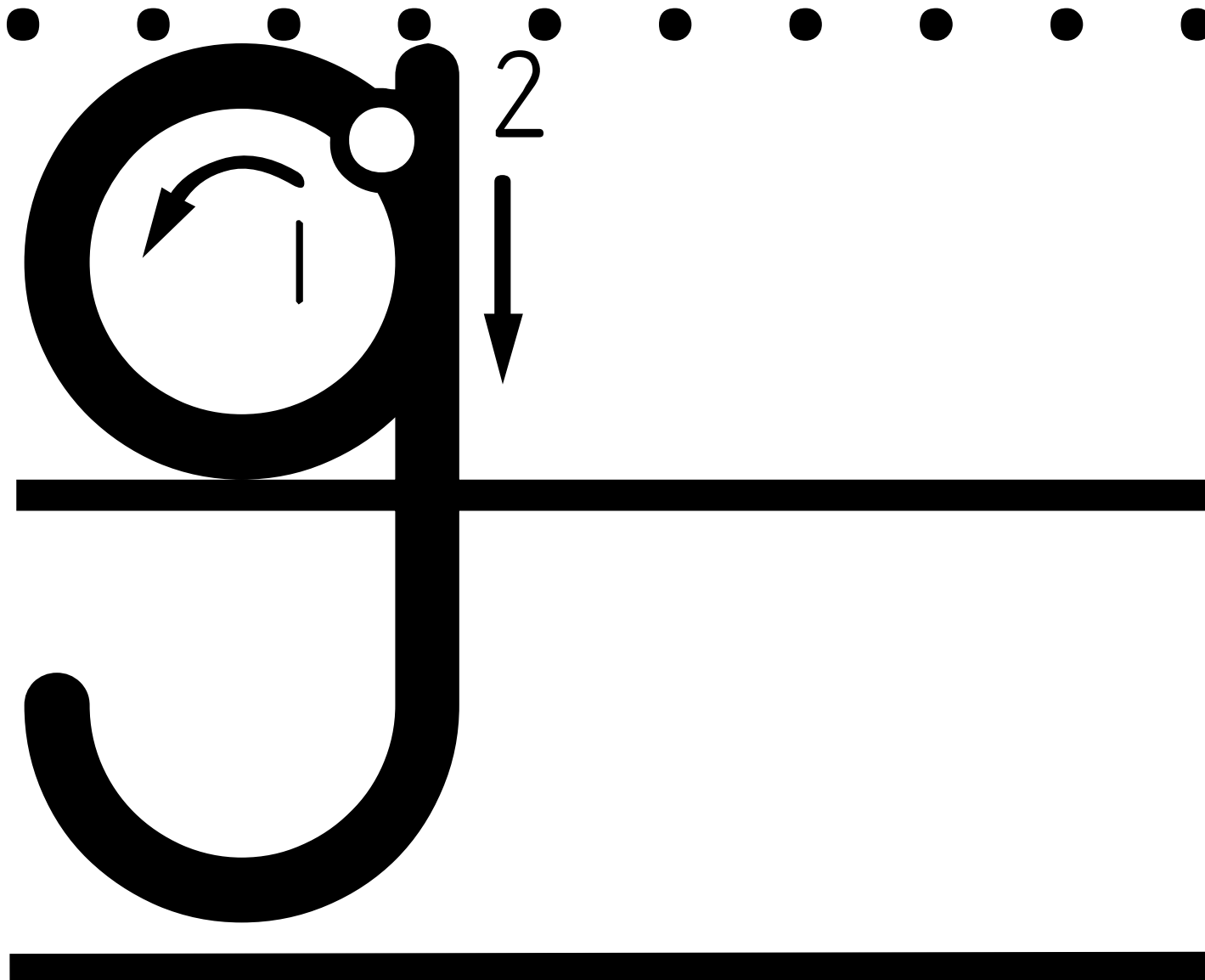
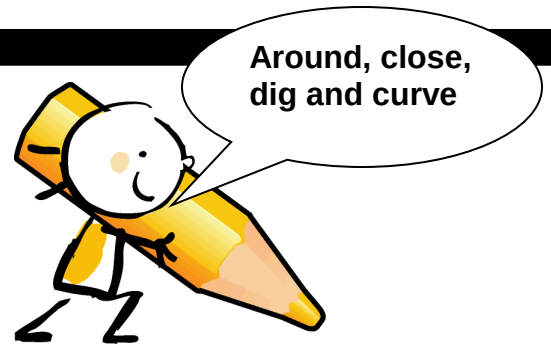

- ☐ Print “digger” letters digging down below baseline (y)

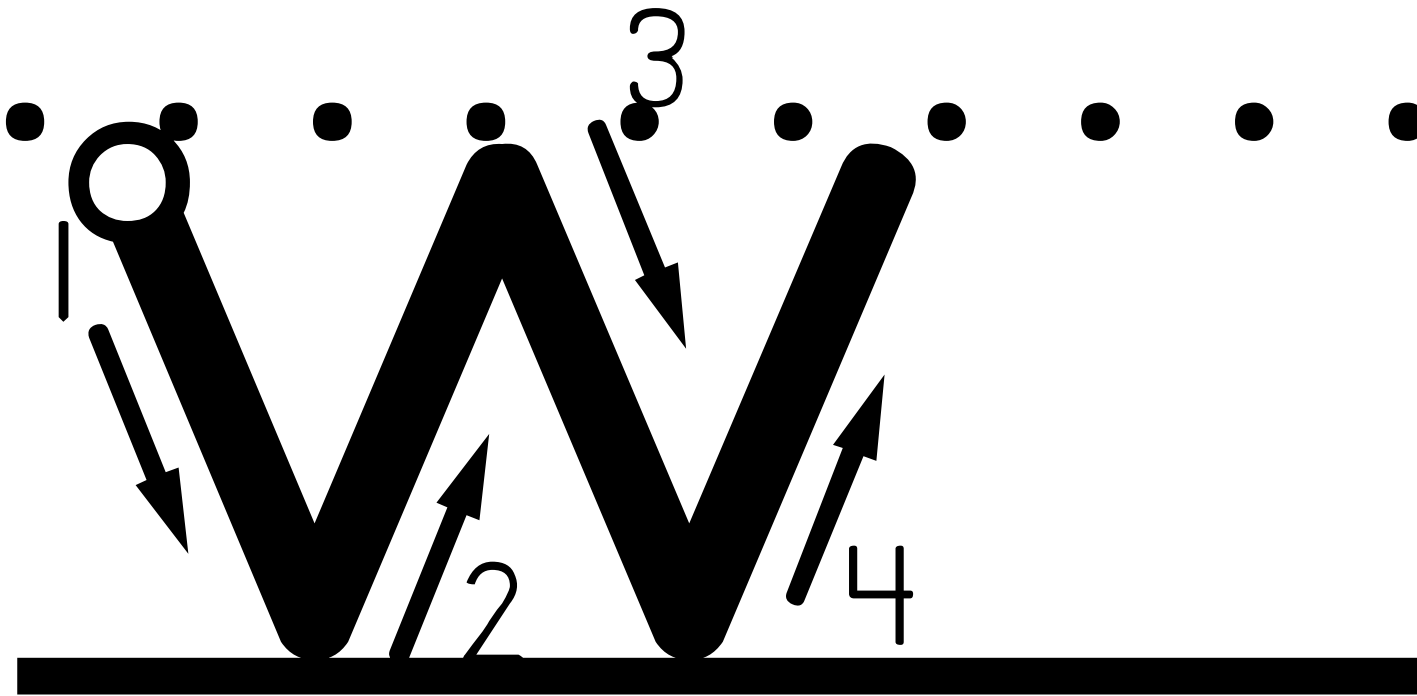
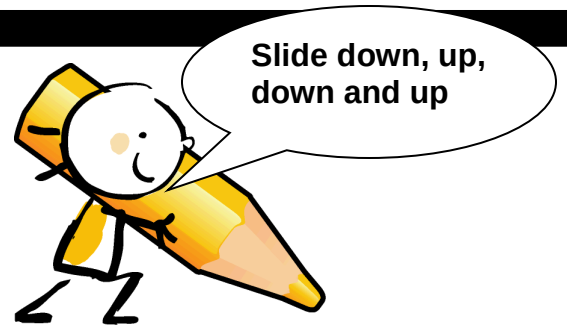
