


Speech Input

With Microsoft Edge you can use your voice to enter text anywhere.


- 1. Click on a text box (such as the address bar or search engine)
- 2. Press Windows + H
- 3. Click on the microphone to enter text.
- 4. Press the "Enter" key to search.



Read Aloud

Microsoft Edge will read any text out loud. To enter Read Aloud:

- 1. Right click on the first word you want read.
- 2. Click on "Read Aloud"
- 3. Use the *play* and *skip* controls at the top of the screen to move between paragraphs.




Tip: You can also enter Immersive Reader by highlighting a selection of text, right clicking and choose Open in Immersive Reader.

Immersive Reader

You can use Immersive Reader to help you remove distractions on websites. Immersive Reader also lets you manipulate the text size, color, spacing, and language of the text.

- From a website, push F9 to enter Immersive Reader.
- 2. Use the buttons on the top right hand corner to make adjustments.



Accessibility Settings

There are many more accessibility setting in the Edge Browser.

You can access these settings by clicking on the three dots "..." in the top right corner of the screen.

Choose "Settings" and then click on "Accessibility" to see the full range of options.
