Accuracy

Did you read the words correctly?

• Think, if it doesn't make sense, go back and reread it.





Expression

Pay attention to your voice...

 show the character's feelings, use of different voices, read bolded words, and read punctuation clues





Rate

Think, does your reading sound like talking?

- Use the punctuation to tell you how to read the sentences and where to take a BREATH.
- Do not read too fast, smooth it out

Phrasing

Break sentences into phrases...

- Sound out unknown words
- Group the words into phrases using the punctuation clues
- Reread the sentence in smooth phrases that sound like talking






Intonation & Stress
