

Set-up a School District iTunes Account

An iPad used in an educational setting should not be logged into a personal iTunes account. These devices are set-up for teacher use and you should create an iTunes account with your appropriate school district email. When asked for a payment method do not attach to a credit card and select 'None'. This type of account will allow you to add free Apps to your school district iPad but any Apps that cost would need to be purchased through the technology department. When the applications are purchased this way we can bulk purchase them at half the price. In addition, by purchasing through the technology department we then have the flexibility of being able to transfer Apps from one device to another.




Set-up a School District Apple iD on an iPad

- 1. Open the App Store, iTunes Store, or iBooks Store.
- 2. Choose any free app, song, video, or book.
- 3. Tap Get next to the item, then tap again to get it.



4. When you're asked to sign in with an Apple ID, tap Create New Apple ID.

5. Follow the onscreen instructions. When you're asked for payment information, choose None.



6. After you enter all of the information required, you'll be asked to verify your Apple ID by email. **Please use your School District email address**. You must verify your Apple ID before you can begin using it.

To Set-up a School District Apple iD using a Mac or PC Computer

1. Open iTunes, then go to the iTunes Store by clicking the iTunes Store button at the top of the window.



2. Scroll down and find the country flag in the lower-right corner of the window. If it's not the flag of the country where you live, click it and choose your country or region.




3. Go to the App Store, Music, TV Shows, or Books section of the store by clicking on one of the icons in the upper-left corner.



4. Download a free app, song, video, or book. To find free items, look in the right column of the window and click any link that includes the word "Free," such as "Free on iTunes" or "Top Free." When you find a free item, click Get beneath its icon.



5. When you're asked to sign in with an Apple ID, click Create Apple ID.



6. Follow the onscreen instructions. When you're asked for payment information, choose None as the payment type.



7. After you enter all of the information required, you'll be asked to verify your Apple ID by email. <u>Please use your School District email address</u> You must verify your Apple ID before you can begin using it.
