Effective Writing Instruction

- create an engaged community of writers
- provide daily writing time
- teach students the writing process
- teach students to write for a variety of purposes
- teach fluent printing, spelling, sentence construction, and typing

Motivating Student Writing

- emphasis success at each stage of the process, not just at the product stage
- provide scaffolds to increase student engagement
- make writing relevant to students by assigning writing for real purposes and audiences
- model strategies to show success in writing
- provide opportunities for peer collaboration
- give actionable, user-friendly feedback
- create a supportive, nonthreatening classroom environment




Transcription [Foundational Writing Skills]
