How single sign on will impact the students

What has changed?

All devices, sites and email will now be accessed using the @sd22.bc.ca domain. The @sd22learns.ca will no longer be used as it has been replaced with the @sd22.bc.ca domain.

What about all my work?

Staff and students will still have everything in your google drive, one drive and other products (google classroom, etc.) exactly as before. You will just sign in with your new domain (sd22.bc.ca).

Will students know their usernames?

For students in K-8 their email address will be pupilnumber@sd22.bc.ca. For students in 9-12 their username has remained the same number as in previous years. For ease of access all student emails are listed in MyEdBC and can be printed in bulk that way too.

What if a student can't get in?

If a student does not know their password, the default password is their birthday in the form of MMDDYY.
